Sikh Channel Aid was established in 2013 as a branch of Sikh Channel Community Broadcasting Company Limited (Charity No.1136163). Our charity focus is a faith inspired approach towards all our humanitarian endeavours , primarily the Sikhi concepts of compassion and humanity.

SCA promotes these ideals through two distinguishable channels – emergency and/or disaster relief, and social aid projects such as the opening of academies, monetary aid for families in need, and free medical assistance. Our ultimate goal is to promote the ideal of self-sufficiency and, with the help of our intervention, to enable individuals to make this ideal a reality.

Respectively, we have pursued the following projects:- In 2015 and 2016, SCA in collaboration with ShelterBox dedicated our efforts to providing emergency aid and relief to the victims of the Nepalese earthquake and to the victims of Hurricane Matthew in Haiti. On a social scale, we have conducted projects primarily in India, focussing predominately on those areas and individuals in most need. We begun a documented series highlighting the issues facing farmer families who are crippled with burdening debts and have suffered loss through the suicides of the family breadwinners. We adopted an entire village, Jhangola, in which we established a free medical dispensary as well as a water filtration plant in order to secure the basic amenities of the locals. We are also in the process of opening a brand new, fully stocked academy in the village of Vijaywada in order to provide educational facilities for the local children, many of whom are orphaned.

Sikh Channel Aid is dedicated to providing the same level of compassion and commitment across the world and ensuring that we are able to reach out to as many of those in need as possible.
